DEER RESISTANT

This list includes plants that are browsed less frequently than others... according to articles I've found online. No plant is completely deer proof. Some of these plants, our customers have told us, their neighborhood deer have eaten. Any young or hungry deer is going to try anything. If you have a large deer population in your neighborhood I would advise a fence, deer sprav or planting with little cages around the plants until they are big enough and strong enough to live through a deer nibbling on them.
