



GROWING ASPARAGUS

SOAK THE CROWNS BEFORE PLANTING

FULL SUN IS BEST (AT LEAST 6HRS), BUT PART SUN IS OK TOO

DIG A TRENCH 12 IN. WIDE AND 6 IN. DEEP (8 IN. IN SANDY SOIL)

PLACE THE CROWNS 1.5FT – 2FT APART

TOP THEM WITH 2 TO 3 INCHES OF SOIL. TWO WEEKS LATER, ADD ANOTHER INCH OR TWO OF SOIL. CONTINUE ADDING SOIL PERIODICALLY UNTIL THE SOIL IS SLIGHTLY MOUNDED ABOVE SURFACE LEVEL TO ALLOW FOR SETTLING.

WATER REGULARLY THE FIRST TWO YEARS. MULCH TO PREVENT THE WEEDS TAKING OVER. FERTILIZE IN SPRING AND FALL.

EAT YUMMY SPEARS THAT YOU GREW AND BE HAPPY
